

Jonah 3: Relenting and Repenting

God is always eager to show us mercy.

1. Jonah Preaches (3:1-4)

1 Timothy 2:3-4

Is God calling you to go, like Jonah to Nineveh, and declare and show who he is? Does he want you to have confidence that his Spirit will work even if your message isn't perfect?

2. Nineveh Repents (3:5-9)

Joel 2:12-14a

Is God asking you to repent like the Ninevites? Is he asking you to believe God's definition of sin and to turn away from it, to him, without excuses or rationalizing?

3. God Relents (3:10)

Hebrews 13:8; 2 Chronicles 7:14; Colossians 6:7

Does God want to reassure you that he is merciful, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love (Joel 2:13)? Does he want you to be confident that his mercy is available to everyone who repents, even you?
