- Five questions that express feelings of being abandoned.
- 1. Worn down by troubled heart
- 2. Forgotten forever
- 3. The Lord no longer sees or blesses you
- 4. Wrestling with dark thoughts that lead to sorrow
- 5. Despair over the enemy's tyranny

II. Petition: Pursue The Lord And His Deliverance – vv. 3-4


- Prayers in the opposite spirit for all the things you feel the Lord is not doing.
- 1. "Look on me and help"
 - Psalm 46:1
- 2. "Answer me, I am listening"
 - Psalm 40:1
- 3. "Light up my eyes before it's too late"
 - Ephesians 1:17-20
- 4. "Deliver me from my enemy"

III. Rejoice: Praise Him For His Love And Salvation – vv. 6-7

- Upward declarations of faith in who the Lord is for you despite what you may feel.
- 1. Anchored Trust in the Lord's steadfast love
 - Psalm 143:8-9, Roman 8:38-39
- 2. A Heart that rejoices in the Lord's salvation
 - Psalm 143:11
- 3. Hope that sings of the Lord's abundant goodness!
 - Psalm 27:13-14, Matthew 28:20b

How To Pray: Upward. Inward. Outward
