- 3. Jesus frees us for sonship
 - Colossians 1:13-14, John 8:34-36

II. <u>Revelation Of The Father's Will</u> - vv. 8-9

- 1. We find wisdom and insight in Christ
 - Colossians 2:2-3
- 2. It is his good pleasure and purpose to reveal his will

III. <u>Reconciliation Of Brokenness</u> - v. 10

- Colossians 1:19-22
- 1. Restoration of all heaven, all people, and all creation
