- Luke 24:45, 49, John 7:37-39
1. Under the influence of drugs vs. being under the control of the Spirit – vv. 18
 - Ephesians 1:13-14, 17; 2:22; 3:16; 4:3; 6:17, 18
 2. Offering Joyful words to one another and the Lord – v.19
 3. Giving thanks always and continually to God – v. 20
 4. Submitting to one another out of reverence for Christ – v. 21
 - Philippians 2:3-5
