

Sermon: “I AM” Delivers Us! – Exodus 1-17, John 8:57-59; 1:29

We are going to need a revelation of who God is if we are going to be really free!

Intro.

Moses’ Concerns

1. Who am I that I should go? (3:11).
2. What is your name, that I may tell the people who sent me? (3:13).
3. How would the people believe that you have sent me? (4:1).
4. I am not eloquent; I am slow of speech (4:10).
5. Please send someone else! (4:13).

Yahweh’s Responses

- I will be with you; I have sent you, you shall serve me on this mountain (3:12).
- I Am Who I Am; Yahweh, the God of your fathers Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob (3:14–15).
- Yahweh gives three signs for people to believe - Staff into serpent; healing a leprous hand; Water into blood (4:1-9).
- I, Yahweh, made your mouth, I will be with your mouth, and teach you what to say (4:11-12).
- Yahweh becomes angry with Moses’ resistance to his will; Your brother Aaron will help you! (4:14–16).
