- 1. Perpetually complains to others and is always discontented
 - ... in their misfortunes Numbers 11:1-2
 - ... in God's food provision Numbers 11:4-6, 20

Story 2:

- 2. Fear their circumstances instead of believing in the Lord
 - 10 spies bring back a bad report Numbers 13:32-33
- 3. Rebels against authority and wants control over their lives
 - Numbers 14:1-4, 11

II. A Believer's Heart Turns Toward The Lord

Story 1:

- 1. Bring your complaint to God in prayer
 - Moses complains to God Numbers 11:11-12, 15-16

Story 2:

- 2. Trust and obey the Lord in every situation
 - Two spies bring back a good report Numbers 14:8-9, 20-24, 26-29
