- I. I'm Called By His Grace Jeremiah 1:4-5
 - 1. I knew you before you were born
 - Jeremiah, David Psalm 139:16
 - 2. I consecrated you for a holy purpose
 - Paul Galatians 1:15
 - 3. I appointed you for a special calling
 - Now you Ephesians 2:10

II. I'm Fearless In His Presence – Jeremiah 1:6-8

- 1. Do not say you are unqualified
 - Joshua 1:9
- 2. Do not be afraid of them
 - Jeremiah 20:10-11a
- 3. I am with you!

III. I'm Empowered To Do His Will – Jeremiah 1:9-10

- 2 Corinthians 4:7
- 1. To uproot and break down
- 2. To rebuild and replant

Close: Ezekiel's Message Of Hope - Ezekiel 36:24-28

- This is the gospel message of hope that we too share with others!
- 1. The Lord will take you out of places of oppression v. 24
- 2. The Lord will cleanse you from all sin v. 25
- 3. The Lord will restore you into the person you were meant to be -v. 26
- 4. The Lord will empower you with his Spirit so that you can walk in his ways v. 27
- 5. The Lord will bring you into his family v. 28
