Intro: Peter Calls Us To Live Like Daniel

- 1 Peter 2:11-13a
- Like Daniel, Christians find themselves as exiles in strange land with the challenge of how to represent God in the workplace.

Believers who live like Daniel in the marketplace will experience the Lord's blessings on their work and reflect God's light to their boss. Daniel gives us three stories to instruct us.

I. Resisting Cultural Assimilation – Daniel 1

- Daniel 1:2, 8-9, 17
- When we honor God by not compromising our faith, **he gives** us what we need to succeed for his glory.

Daniel's Psalm:

- 1. God has all the wisdom & might Daniel 2:20
- 2. God has ultimate control Daniel 2:21a
- 3. God gives us his wisdom & might Daniel 2:21b-23

II. Faithful Through The Fire – Daniel 3

- Daniel 3:5-6, 12, 15, 17-18, 25, 28-29
- Daniel's friends would rather take a stand and **trust** their lives to God than worship something false.

III. Praying With The Lions - Daniel 6

- 1. Excellent Work Ethic Daniel 6:3-4, 16
- 2. Excellent Moral Character Daniel 6:3-4, 22
- 3. Excellent Spiritual Life Daniel 6:3, 10, 14, 18, 23
 - Daniel was **deeply valued** and indispensable to King Darius because of his spiritual excellence!
