II. <u>Why Do You Notice Us Or Care For Us So Much?</u> – Hebrews 2:6

• Psalm 8:3

III. <u>We Were Made For So Much More Than This!</u> – Hebrews 2:7-8a

- 1. "Made for a little while lower than the angel" v. 7
 - We were Humbled in our creation
 - Genesis 1:27
- 2. "Crowned with glory and honor" -v.7
 - We were Exalted to rule
 - Genesis 1:28

IV. <u>But We See Jesus, Who Saves Us and Rules All Things</u> – Hebrews 2:8b-9

- 1. Jesus' Humiliation was in order to Save us v. 9
 - Philippians 2:8-9
- 2. Jesus' Exaltation is for him to Rule all things -v.9
 - The word "subjection" is a key word and thought of this passage and speaks to Jesus' rule over all things.
 - In his exaltation we are lifted up with him!
 - John 12:27-28, 31-36
