The Holy Spirit says, “*Today, if you hear his voice, do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion.*”

I. A Warning From The Holy Spirit To Pay Attention To God’s Voice – Hebrews 3:7-11

II. An Admonition To Not Have A Doubting Heart – Hebrews 3:12-14

1. Take Care, To Guard Your Heart From Doubt & Drift – v. 12

- Hebrews 3:1; 2:1

2. Strongly Encourage One Another At Church To Trust & Obey – v. 13

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3. Hold Your Confidence In Christ With Intestinal Fortitude – v. 14

- Hebrews 3:1, 3, 6
- Intestinal fortitude means we have the strength of mind and courage (i.e. guts) to do something difficult or unpleasant because our confidence is in Christ.

III. A Lesson From History On Those Who Do Not Enter Their Rest – Hebrews 3:15-19

- Hebrews 3:15 (The Message)

Close: Psalm 95:1-7
