

Title: The Self, Thought Again

Text: Mark 8:27-38

- 1st** – Bible does not use the word “selfish” (some English translations do when covering, “Impure ambitions.”)
2nd – Bible never uses the word “selfless” - as if not being a self would be a good thing.

Ephesians 4:11-13 – Jesus makes us mature selves.

Does Not Mean – You should have no self/identity.

Does Not Mean – Self-hatred is good.

Is Not Meant – to give you endless guilt in life.

Is Not an Excuse – for lacking courage.

DOES Mean – Giving up / filling in the dark portions of self. (Romans 6:6/11)

DOES Mean – Attend to God’s calling (Galatians 1:1, 1 Timothy 4:7/12/16).

*Since Jesus is the fullest self, his example shows us how to walk into his will for us.

Question: Are you a full self, half-self, or no-self?

Apply in your life

- 1 - Avoid Telling God what to do
- 2 - Acknowledge God’s path – as path to the full self.
