

The Redeemer & Restorer Of Life – Ruth 4:13-22

The Lord works with those who build bridges of hese to help redeem and restore full lives.

Intro. - הֶסֶד (hese) is a **loyal compassionate love** expressing itself as **magnanimous acts of kindness** to those in need.

I. The Lord Is Working Providentially With Us To Build Bridges Of Hese - Ruth 4:13-14

- Ruth 4:14, Romans 8:28 (NIV)
- 1. Natural Laws – Ruth 1:6; 4:13
- 2. Chance Encounters – Ruth 2:3, 4; 4:1

II. The Lord Works Through Our Hese To Redeem Those Without Hope – Ruth 4:14

No hope - Ruth 1:12-13

Hese (1:8) ➡ Redeemer (2:20; 3:9-10) ➡ Hope – (4:14)

III. The Lord Works Through Our Hese to Restore Life For Those Who Are Empty – Ruth 4:15-17

Emptiness - Ruth 1:19-21 “returned me back empty”

Great Reversal – Ruth 4:15-17 “a returner of life”

IV. Jesus Our King, Redeemer, & Restorer – Ruth 4:18-22

King – Judges 21:25, Ruth 4:22, Matthew 1:5-6a, 16; 2:1-2

Redeemer - Titus 2:14

Restorer - John 10:10
