Jesus' love is satisfying and abundant

1. Jesus' abundant satisfying love provides more than expected

Ruth 2:14, 17-18; Psalm 23:5; John 10:10; Psalm 37:3-4

Start by spending time with Jesus

Reflection Questions

Read Ruth 2:14, 17-18; Psalm 23:5; John 10:10; Psalm 37:3-4

1. What is the difference between working for Jesus' blessing and Jesus blessing your work?
2. What would abundant provision look like this season of your life?
3. Can you relate to (a) and/or (b)?
(a) the more time I spend with Jesus, the more I crave His presence
(b) it is hard for me to start spending time with Jesus because have no desire
4. What are practically ways to start spending time with Jesus?

Read Ruth 2:19-20; Ephesians 3:20

5. How do the words "hesed" and "redeemer" connect us to the rest of the Biblical narrative?
6. How does us being full of Jesus' abundant and satisfying love turn us into a channel of blessing for others?

Read Ruth 2:21-23; Psalm 136; John 6:35

7. Reflect of the phrase "for his steadfast love endures forever" for 30 seconds in silence. What comes to mind? Any specific words, images, feelings or impressions?

8. One at a time, say something you are thankful for, and everyone else respond by saying "your love endures forever"
9. What does Jesus mean that we will not hunger or thirst if we go to Him?
10. Explain in a sentence how Jesus' love is satisfying and abundant.
